DIRECTION

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supervise all field operations, such as measurements, drawing of sketches, construction staking, property corner staking, and other data collection.
- Act as the point-of-contact for clients in the field and communicate the progress of the project to the Survey Manager and/or engineer.
- Provide guidance to technicians on use of survey equipment and ensure that crew members follow standard procedures.
- Use field data and notes to draft projects to completion using CADD software.
- Operate GPS and scanning equipment with knowledge of their capabilities.
- Manage daily downloading of data collectors.
- Troubleshoot problems with field equipment and fix minor issues in the field.
- Inform the Survey Manager about survey equipment that needs repairs or supplies that need to be ordered.

- Boundary/cadastral survey experience (GDOT/ALDOT/TDOT database prep experience preferred)

- Trimble survey equipment experience (Total Station and GPS)
- Ability to perform calculations and work with computer programs
- 107 pilots license (preferred)
- Precise field note keeping and documentation skills
- Ability to walk long distances, work overtime/nights/weekends/out of town (as needed)
- Ability to work in Atlanta, Huntsville, and Chattanooga (as needed)
- Valid driver's license and clean motor vehicle report
